Corporate Confession of Sin

Our merciful God and heavenly Father, we acknowledge and confess our great sinfulness before you, because of our sins, the sins of our magistrates, and the sins of our whole nation, to which we are in many ways accomplices. Yet in spite of all this, we draw near to the throne of grace, encouraging ourselves with the hope of a gracious answer to our prayers, and with the confidence of the exceeding great and precious promises of mercy and grace in the new covenant. We humbly and earnestly ask you for mercy, for the free and full remission of all our sins, because of the bitter sufferings and precious merits of our Savior Jesus Christ. Our Father, we pray that you would condescend to pour out your love in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, to seal within us the full assurance of our pardon and reconciliation, to comfort all who mourn in Zion, to speak peace to the wounded and troubled spirit, and bind up the broken-hearted, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.
